# Terms & Conditions apply:

- 1 Four players per team
- 2 Participants must attend a second level school
- 3 Two relay competitions will take place on 04/03/2012
  - Junior Relay competition and Senior Relay competition
  - Five teams will compete in each race
- 4 Teams will be selected via a draw at the Camogie Association Offices on Monday, February 20th, 2012
- 5 The age limit for entry to the Senior Relay is as follows:  
Participants competing in the Senior Relay Race must adhere to the age limits pertaining to the All-Ireland Post Primary Schools Senior Championship and be under 19 on 1st July prior to the commencement of the competition  
Date of birth must be included on entry form
- 6 The age limit for entry to the Junior Relay is as follows:  
Participants competing in the Junior Relay race must adhere to the age limit for the Junior championship and be under 16 on the 1st Jan of the academic year  
Date of birth must be included on entry form
- 7 Participants will be informed via their school of their selection to participate in Camán & Run
- 8 One adult must accompany each team of four to the Senior & Junior Relay Race and act as co-ordinator for the team  
The details of the co-ordinator must be on the above form
- 9 A member of the Camogie Association Regional Development Team will contact the School & Team Co-ordinator to make arrangements regarding Camán & Run 2012 if your team is chosen
