ROLE PROFILE

Position: **Camogie County Development Officer**

Role description: The overall role of the County Development Officer is to ensure that Coaching & Games Development Activities are co-ordinated within their county.

Please note: **IF** the county has a County Coaching & Games Development Committee. He/she should be chairperson.

Please note: The Camogie Association strongly recommends that a County Development Committee be put in place – a committee ensures sharing of workload and that the whole county is being catered for.

Works with: County Executive Board/Camogie Regional Development Officer

Responsibilities: To liaise and work with the regional development officer on a development plan for your county under five points below.

1. To ensure the county is active under Coach & Referee education. To organise courses and workshops.
2. To plan and organise *Go Games* Blitzes and Leagues from U8 to U12 and ensure they are completed
3. To facilitate best practice in underage intercounty development of U14/U15 and U17 teams and ensure they are organised in accordance with national policy
4. CDO* liaising with RDO and County Boards in bringing to the attention any new club development area or any assistance clubs in the county require in a development context.
5. To report to the County Convention on Games Development Activities in the County.
