Code of Conduct for the Camogie Referee

- Referees have responsibility for the safety of players under their guidance
- They must know the rules of the game and apply them fairly
- Referees should show respect for the players, coaches, spectators and the sport
- Referees should conduct themselves honourably at all times maintaining the dignity of the position
- Referees should not tolerate or allow abusive language or behaviour
- Referees should demonstrate respect for diversity, sex, creed and promote equality
- Work as part of a team of officials
- Demonstrate honesty and integrity
- Set a positive personal example by promoting good behaviour and showing respect to everyone involved in the game
- Prepare physically and mentally for every game
- Complete and submit accurate and concise reports within the time limits required in games in which they officiate
- Above all retain integrity, consistency and uniformity
- Be committed to the protection of players
- Be able to accept unfair criticism
- Be able to accept constructive criticism
